

Plan -

This all depends on what you actually want but -

I will try to come one day per week until it is sorted to the point of easy maintenance. As I do it I would plan on putting any garden waste, that I can't use or get in the bin, into builders ton bags and put them on the front where the skip was. Then you can get a skip when all done if needed or take to tip or whatever.

1. Cut down and remove trees and erect fence to keep Bjorn in etc. Depending on the type of fence one could put wire along and grow up it. Plant out a thinnish border at base in spring.
2. Cut and dig out lvy, trim back as much as possible but let rest die back naturally.
3. Trim back bottom trees as much as possible and lower the height to a manageable amount - this will increase garden size and view but may impact on your, and neighbours privacy.
4. Dig out any unwanted shrubs. Reduce border to lawn? replant with lower shrubs and/or move them more to the middle of the bed so that pathway has more space. Remove thorny rose by side of garage.
5. 5 put in raised veg patch utilising logs and trunks from trees? or maybe sleepers - the idea being to use natural and cheap materials that can easily be removed if you change your mind but will still do the job and look natural.
6. Anything else that comes up (such as dealing with an old swimming pool???) and general tidy and make good.
